





BULK FUEL PROCUREMENT PROGRAM

Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate Unit 13 Collaborative Services (IU13) has partnered with PAPCO to offer a Bulk Fuel Procurement Program. The commodities that can be purchased include #2 fuel oil, bio-diesel, and gasoline (87 and 89 octane).

Program Information

Hedging: Fuel is purchased via layered hedges from the NYMEX market, ensuing low costs with a long term contract in place to provide strategic procurement opportunities.

Pricing: Fixed price is in place by annual contract start date IU13 negotiates pricing and terms based on the aggregation of requirements and marketplace conditions.

Contract: Supplier qualification, due diligence, and negotiated contract is completed and in place. No additional management of the program is required.

Team of Professionals: The procurement process is professionally managed by a team of PAPCO Energy Managers, with oversight from IU13 and an Energy Advisory Team.

Transparency: A documentation trail is provided for all procurement transactions.

Service and Support: IU13 provides dispute resolution with supplier and additional customer service if necessary.

Value Added Services: Program has the ability to split loads, share commitments, and tank analysis services.

Reporting: Providing participants with monthly and annual reporting containing the following;

- Market summary
- Current program buying group pricing
- Benchmarking data
